I recently had an e-mail from someone who had accessed our Website and asked for prayer. She said that as soon as she typed in her request, the answer came. The Department of Medicine, Beilinson Campus, Rabin Medical Center in Petah-Tiqva, Israel did a blind study. They chose 3393 patients with a bloodstream infection. 1691 patients were randomized to an intervention group and 1702 to a control group. The 1691 patients assigned to an intercessory prayer group showed remarkable results in the following areas: number of deaths, length of stay in the hospital and duration of fever. Results: fewer deaths (28.1% in the intervention compared with 30.2% in control group, Length of stay in hospital and duration of fever were significantly lower in the intervention group.

The Intervention Group (those who prayed for the patients) were not on location. The patients did not know they were being prayed for. The prayers did not know the patients.
